You can now access updated specifications for the PTI Generic File, Version 4.9.6, set to release on April 9, 2013.

SUMMARY

- **Detail Record 2 (D2)** – A new field “Card Attribute Indicator” (position 107-108) was added to provide further clarification on transactions, such as PIN capability and whether the transaction was impacted due to the card product opt-in requirements imposed by the Canadian Code of Conduct.
- **Detail Addenda Record Debit (D5, Type 01)** – An existing field, “Debit Issuer Data” (position 76-80), has approximately nine additional valid values added for STAR Debit Network transactions. In addition, a new valid value has been added for PULSE debit network transactions.
- **Detail Addenda Record Healthcare Auto-substantiation (D5, Type 11)** – This field has been expanded from supported credit transactions to include Interlink[®] and PULSE[®] debit transactions. There are no record changes as a result.
- **Appendix I: Authorization POS Entry Mode** – Discover[®] -related values were added to both the POS Entry Mode table and the Discover Specific Values table
- **Appendix K: POS Data Code** – New values were added to the Discover POS Data Code table.
