## Process Overview

Chase Paymentech has implemented a Heartbeat application that all merchants processing Online Authorizations to our Stratus machines, using one of the many Chase Paymentech proprietary online Online formats (minimum required Revision 3.0), can take advantage of. The Heartbeat process will be used to ensure "application to application" connectivity between Chase Paymentech and the merchant.

Chase Paymentech will initiate a Heartbeat message upon a successful merchant connection. The Heartbeat message will be sent every 120 seconds. The merchant's application will send a response to Chase Paymentech's request message. If Chase Paymentech does not receive a response within 120 seconds of sending the request message, or the response is incorrect, the Chase Paymentech application will reset the connection to a listen state. Since Chase Paymentech is the "server", the merchant's application will see a socket disconnect and should recover accordingly.

The Heartbeat application will use a sequence number and Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) within the messages. GMT is supported on all computer systems.

The following is the specification for the Chase Paymentech initiated request, and the Merchant's response to the request.
